Teaching and Learning Methods	<p>This course is conducted through lectures and activities centered on 'situations', 'functions', and 'topics'.</p> <p>In this course, new grammar and vocabulary are presented using visual materials such as PowerPoint and pictures, and students can practice grammar and vocabulary through controlled conversations.</p> <p>In order for students to become more fluent in using the target grammar and expressions, this course will provide more opportunities for individual speaking, role-playing, practice, and teamwork.</p>
