Students also learn grammar and expressions that appear in Korean dramas by watching them on video.</p> <p>This class will be wrapped with various types of activities such as personal speech, role-playing, team playing that give more opportunities for practice so that students may become more fluent with the target grammar and vocabulary.</p> | |
